






We are currently seeking volunteers to host the University District (Seattle), Renton and Factoria Petcos. Let us know if you or someone you know might be interested!



Petting Chart for Your Greyhound









GPAGNW has signed-on with Trupanion's Shelter Program to offer free activation of a pet insurance policy to all of our new adopters. There will be a certificate in each of our Adoption Packets from now on explaining the program. To activate the policy, the adopter needs to take their new dog for an initial vet visit, then activate the policy within 24 hours of the visit. The activation can be done on Trupanion's website or over the phone. Activating the policy will cost nothing and at the end of the first 30 days the adopter can choose to let the policy lapse, or to pay their first monthly premium to continue it. Trupanion waives its customary waiting periods in this program, so full coverage is effective the moment the certificate is activated.

















The ancient art of Greyhound folding.
